

ESOL Beginner Teacher

At Notre Dame Refugee Centre, we extend a warm welcome to refugees and asylum seekers. Our centre is a place where individuals can find expert advice and the opportunity to participate in a range of activities at the centre.

Role Description

On Mondays and Thursdays, we run our drop-in sessions from 10:00am-2:00pm. During these sessions we run English classes from Pre-Beginner to Intermediate level. The ESOL Beginner Teacher will provide English classes to individuals who have minimal knowledge of English. This role involves creating an inclusive, supportive, and effective learning environment that addresses the foundational aspects of the English language, including basic vocabulary, pronunciation, and simple phrases for everyday communication. The teacher will assess learners' needs, monitor progress, and adapt lessons to ensure understanding and engagement. **This class takes place on Mondays from 10:30am to 12:00pm.** This role requires a commitment of **6 months (two terms)**.

Person Specification

Essential

- A recognised teaching qualification in ESOL or a related field.
- Demonstrated experience in teaching English at beginner levels.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills.
- Ability to design and implement lesson plans that cater to the specific needs of beginner learners.
- Sensitivity to cultural differences and the challenges faced by learners in adapting to a new language environment.

Desirable

- Experience in a multicultural teaching environment.
- Familiarity with digital learning tools and resources such as Teams and Outlook.
- Experience working or volunteering with refugees or asylum seekers
